Business Update

Our order intake is 20% down on pre covid sales. Over the last 18 months we have seen demand disappear and then surge back. We are on the road to recovery and are winning new customers, but it is challenging as we are experiencing shortages in parts and the cost of steel has increased by 39% but as yet we haven't increased our prices to the customer. We are in a really good position, but it remains challenging due to the impact of Brexit and Covid.

Ali have acquired Welbilt, making Ali by far the biggest, the global leader in the foodservice equipment and solutions industry.

Canteen

Survey will be issued to everyone from the Forum with the options for the canteen:

Option A – Catering company

Option B – Vending machine company with refrigerated food and have a Scan Heat appliance available to heat it up.
